Corporate Information Security Policy

Hellenic Catering conducts its operations to meet the needs and expectations of its customers in the most efficient and secure manner, complying with all applicable standards, laws, and regulations.

The activities of Olympic Catering include:

- Design, Development, Procurement, Production, Packaging, Storage, Distribution, and Disposal of meat products, meat preparations, cooked meals (Cook & Serve, Cook & Chill, Cook & Freeze), salads, sauces, dressings, sandwiches, and preparation of various meals.
- Storage, Distribution, and Disposal of Various Food Products.
- Organization and Implementation of Integrated Mass Catering Services

The physical security of facilities, personnel, documents, software, and sensitive materials is ensured by the company according to relevant policies and procedures.

Department managers are responsible for appropriate training staff so they can safely and effectively use the company's assets provided for their work.

Risk Assessment is a continuous effort aimed at reducing impacts through the implementation of measures. It considers each element's contribution to the company's mission, vulnerabilities, risks, impacts, single points of failure, and the method of quantifying and evaluating risks.

Specifications for procuring new or expanding existing systems also include security requirements based on their mission.

Access to the corporate network and connected devices is controlled. Access to project software development systems is granted only to authorized personnel working on the project.

A centrally controlled system protects the corporate network from known or unknown malicious software. Files containing security functions against malware are automatically updated. The system protects, among others, servers, workstations, and remote computers. A centrally controlled system also protects the internal network from the Internet.

The company has a Business Continuity Plan and maintains its relevance. Olympic Catering's Information Security Management System (ISMS) complies with all applicable requirements of ISO 27001:2022, and the company is committed to the



continuous improvement of the ISMS and ensuring Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability.

This policy is periodically reviewed for its suitability and is available to all internal and externally interested parties as appropriate.
